Guideline for winter and Chinese New Year

During Chinese New Year explosions and fireworks can be extremely frightening for house pets. Given the previous situation, and the fact that the fireworks will be a common occurrence for several days, JAR has issued a guideline for winter and Chinese New Year. This guideline includes several tips that can help you to reduce the stress and anxiety of our beloved pets.

Among other things, we stress to keep pets inside in a quiet, dark area with limited access to windows or other potential hazards. A radio or fan can

provide soothing background noise to drown out the sound of fireworks outside. If you know that your pet's nerves become extremely frazzled during Chinese New Year holiday, contact your veterinarian ahead of time to see if he or she recommends sedating them. Make sure your pets have proper identification in the form of ID tags, so if they escape, you can be quickly contacted when they are found.

Mango is a beautiful girl (DOB April 2010), and used to be a guard for a factory. She got abandoned in a pet hospital by her owner because she lost one leg in a car accident. Due to finance reasons, the hospital couldn't keep her longer, so they wanted to euthanize her instead. The rescuer helps many stray cats in the community for many years. She is a frequent customer at the hospital where Mango was boarding. The hospital staff was sad about what will happen to Mango so they informed the rescuer to come and help.

The first time the rescuer saw her, she was so calm and mellow, not aggressive at all. She seized the rescuer's affection immediately. So the rescuer and her friend decided to take her away from death.

Now they are fostering her in another location temporarily and hope she could find a reliable and willing family who could take good care of her.

Mango has been vaccinated, dewormed, defleaded and given her rabies shot. She is healthy and having 3 legs does not hinder her from being a 'normal' dog...

Lost Pet Guideline

JAR has issued a guideline that could be extremely useful in the terrible event of a pet being lost.

The guideline includes 10 tips that can help you to increase the chance to find your beloved pet.

Among those tips we have:

(1) Do not waste any time, call JAR and other animal rescue groups to let us know about the situation and begin your search as soon as you notice that the animal is missing.

(2) Try to find the local police contact for your residential area. It is always possible that the police may have been picked up your animal and placed it in the local government facility. Often, you only have 48 hours to retrieve the pet (and they do not always inform owners that the pet has been taken before it is euthanized). If the local security in your building/complex speak only Chinese, find someone bi-lingual to assist you.

(3) Ask everybody: neighbors, children, mail carriers, passersby.

Show them a photo of your pet. Even if they have not seen him, they may be willing to keep their eyes open. If you are in an area with more local Chinese residents, see if you can enlist assistance from a bi-lingual neighbor or have someone translate to the management and security of your building/complex, neighbors, etc. that your pet is missing.

Every year many animals are born and abandoned in Shanghai. JAR does its best to rescue, rehabilitate and re-home abandoned animals. However, a major problem is the increasing number of animals being rescued and the lack of foster parents to help with this task. Do you know how important is the foster parent role in the running of an animal rescue organization?

Animal rescue organizations such as JAR always need more foster parents. For you it is a great way to have a "temporary" pet here in Shanghai if you cannot adopt, miss your own pet from home, you want to have a furry companion in general or if your own pet needs a friend to play and have company. By being a foster parent you get a

companion and help save an animal at the same time!




