Guideline to rescue a stray animal ...


On the internet you can find several rescue guidelines from different animal rescue volunteers around the world but, unfortunately, there is no single standard for these guidelines. Hereafter, this article explores the issue based on the experience of several rescuers and foster parents that have faced this situation while living in China.

The first thing that you must keep in mind when you find one or several kittens/puppies abandoned is: "Do not panic!" Indeed, you need to face the situation without getting stressed. If the kitten or puppy desperately needs help,

the worst thing that you can do is to get nervous. You need to be objective and evaluate the situation according to the following points:

1. Does the animal look sick and/or suffering from starvation and/or a disease?
2. If the animal is clearly a stray (regardless of the fact that he/she might look ok) you have to take him/her to the Vet as soon as possible for a general check up).

JAR in "Shanghai Live" (ICS)



TNR Programs in Suzhou and Green Court 2

As you can see in the JAR Blog, we have had many positive developments in our TNR Programs:

(1) **TNR Suzhou (Catnip Diary):** It is increasingly difficult to trap cats that have not already been ear tipped. It seems those who have already been through the system quite like the trap and don't mind using it again. However, those who still need to be neutered are less inclined to venture inside the trap. Perhaps we are reaching our goal faster than we thought, so this month we are counting cats, setting the trap and hoping.

(2) **Green Court 2:** In February 2011 we started doing TNR in Green Court 2 (Jinqiao, Pudong). With the dedicated help of a few residences, we have successfully caught and neutered 2 males and 1 female. Tomorrow is another day ... and another chance to trap a new cat!

We are also developing a TNR program in the vicinity of Shanghai American School. Two cats were already successfully released back out, and other two new cats have been spotted, so we will try and have them trapped and TNR'd.


