JAR in TV Show "Culture Matters" (ICS)

Marvin Manalac (founder of JAR), Zhang Ayi (rescuer of 40 cats), Dr. Stephanie Goltz (Vet) & Gerlinde Plate (dog trainer) were present at the ICS "Culture Matters" shooting on Friday February 25th.

The show had a local celebrity talking about her rescued animals, Stephanie discussing about medical fees and her view about animals in Shanghai, Gerlinde Plate on dog training, rescuer Zhang talking about her 40 rescued cats, and Marvin talking about JAR and what our cause is all about.

The show also had a small adoption

ceremony where Marvin adopted out a puppy to an adopter.

After the recording, the guests and all the audience did a signing event which will propose the signatures to the related government, in hopes to speed up the pace of passing the animal protection law in China ... indeed, this was the most meaningful part of the whole event.

Xiao Hei is one of the 5 dogs (4 are in permanent homes) that were rescued from a Changning construction site. JAR and other rescuers tried rescuing these dogs over a month ago. In fact, Xiao Huang (his brother) got recently adopted!

Xiao Hei is a little shy, but once he has your trust he will be OK.

He has been vaccinated, dewormed, deflead and will be neutered very soon.

Last March 7th, Shanghai Daily issued an article on JAR's animal rescue activities and its adoption days. Among other things, that article pointed to the fact that JAR encourages people to adopt rescued strays instead of buying pets. Animals offered for adoption have all been vaccinated, cleaned and, if their age permits it, sterilized.

TNR Programs (update)

(1) [TNR Suzhou \(Catnip Diary\)](#): Four more cats successfully neutered and vaccinated in March. We have had our eyes on a huge ginger tom for some time, and we finally managed to trap him. Great result even though he let us know that he was not entirely happy with us!

On another note, one of our first rescues, a tiny/malnourished kitten named Sinda, is now big and strong and has had her surgery.

(2) [Bellewood Villas](#): Proposal currently written to be submitted to the developers in hopes that they will agree to finance the TNR scheme. In the meantime, several residents have agreed to do the scheme and are financing some of the cats that are being trapped for neutering/spaying.

(3) [Green Villas](#): A new neighbor of Green Villas noticed, after her arrival, a cat frequently near her house. She found out through Marney Rosen that JAR has humane traps available and a Vet offering discounted rates for spaying and neutering these cats. Hereafter, she picked up the cage and set it up next to her house where quickly captured a younger looking tabby cat. She has set up the cage again, hoping to attract more cats. She will report on her success as it goes.

The first presentation was in the classroom of the 2nd grade students, and then a second was done for all the students of RBIS in the gym.



