## Truckload of 520 dogs rescued from slaughter near Beijing

On April 15, a truckload of 520 dogs was stopped and the animals were rescued by the coming together of activists online (with an outpouring of support from thousands of people). When word of the truck spread on Sina Weibo, hundreds arrived at the scene with mineral water and food, jamming traffic and refusing to let the truck leave. Some 15 hours later, a pet company and an environmental organization gathered the necessary funds (115,000RMB) to buy the dogs.

On that Friday morning, a man named

Alan spotted the truck and suspected the dogs were not being dealt with legally. He personally forced the truck to stop and then put out a call for help. Turned out the dogs (who were on their way to a butcher in Jilin province) were all legally bought and paid for, with proper immunizations and everything. We are looking for people that love bunnies, willing to give each of these two sweethearts a new forever home.

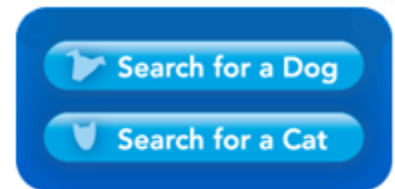
Both are healthy and ready for adoption, preferably separated as they get upset when sharing the same cage or space.

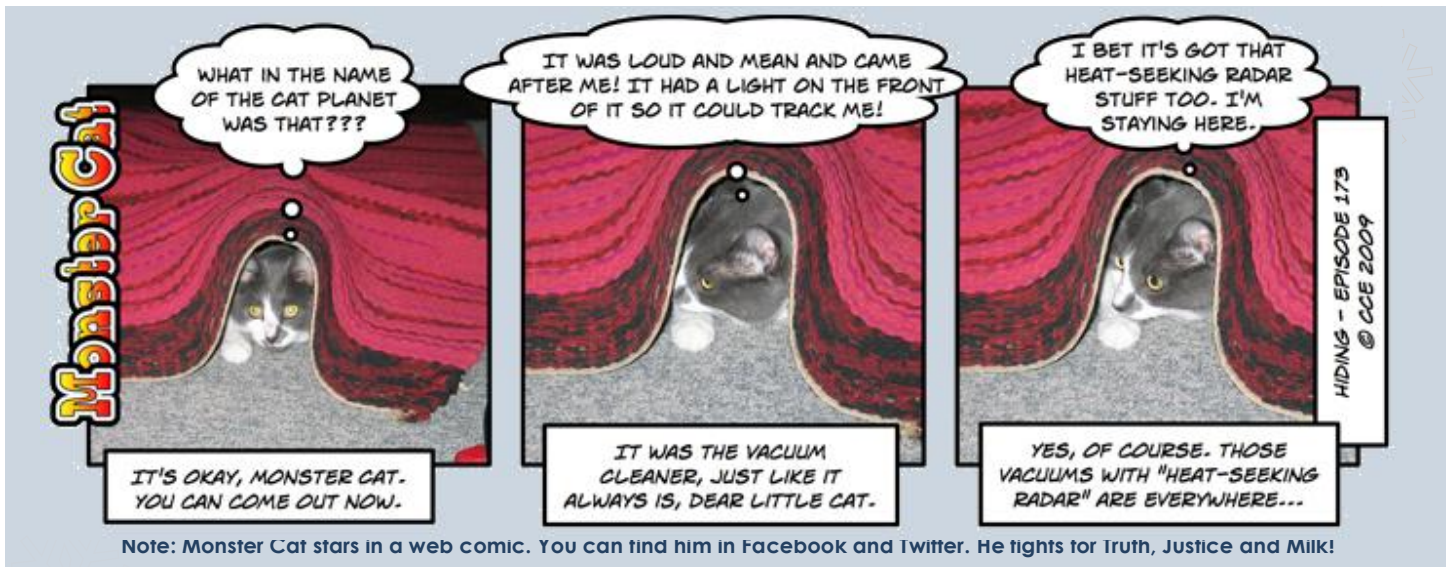

Three more cats have been through the TNR system. We are clinging on with a couple more donations. Unfortunately this is "kitten season" and I am reluctant to trap females at the moment, since I do not want to leave kittens abandoned.

The dilemma around here at the moment is what do we do if we trap a clearly pregnant queen? I am not sure that I know the answer to this. I will discuss it with our Vet. I feel we have to be culturally sensitive in our host country.

We have been reporting on our little rescue cat Sinda since we took her off the streets back in November 2010. Sadly Sinda was killed by a car last week. During the last week of her life, she began approaching us for cuddles and we thought for the first time that she had a future as an adoptee. It was not to be. Sleep peacefully little girl ...

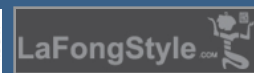
